We applied in partnership with the AKA local chapter and other nonprofits unsuccessfully for funds to support specially disadvantaged African American men and women in Forsyth County impacted by COVID-19. The Department of HHS funded (4) organizations to provide those services through a very competitive grant process with a two week turn around.
